A \$50 non-refundable deposit per family (which will be deducted off your account) needs to be paid on enrolment. This will secure a spot for your child and also assist with final numbers for incursions, excursions and staffing arrangements. Bookings need to be handed in by Monday 11<sup>th</sup> December 2023. Please note all bookings made up to this date will be accepted. Bookings made after this date will be made subject to availability.

Please make sure that your child/ren has enough food and drinks for the day as we do not supply lunch for Vacation Care. We will however be supplying breakfast until 8.30am. When packing your child's lunch and snack, we recommend a healthy lunch box in-line with Nutrition Australia's Healthy Lunchbox Guidelines (feel free to ask our Educators for more information).
