- Immunisation History Statement
- Two documents as proof of permanent residential address. These may include:
 - Contract of sale, title document, or rates notice (for homeowners), or
 - Rental agreement through a real estate agency (for tenants), or
 - A current Centrelink document (e.g. healthcare card), or
 - An ATO document along with one current utility bill (e.g. gas or electricity)

Please note that all documents must be originals or certified copies.

Curriculum News

What's Changing in the Curriculum?

The Vic Curriculum 2.0 introduces a revised structure for Mathematics that breaks learning into smaller, more precise progression points. These are designed to give teachers and families a clearer picture of a student's current level of understanding and skill development.

Rather than grouping students by broad year-level expectations, progression points allow us to identify where each student is at in their learning journey and tailor support and extension accordingly.

What Does This Mean for Learning Tasks?

Learning tasks will be adapted to reflect the updated curriculum structure. This means tasks may look slightly different. You might notice changes in how tasks are described, assessed, and fed back to students. We'll explain how these changes help create a more personalised learning experience during the session.

How Will Reporting Work?

Reports will now reflect the new curriculum format, meaning it will not be compared to the previous curriculum.

Information Session Details:

We will be host an information session in week 8 where we will go through all of this in detail.

This session will be a great opportunity to ask questions and gain a better understanding of how these changes will support your child's learning.

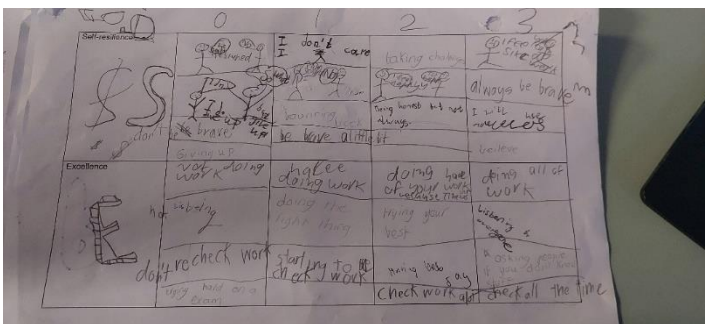
