- Keep a holiday journal with drawings, photos or short notes about each day.

- Encourage children to create graphic novels, movie scrips, recipes, or mini-books.
- Involve children in tasks such as writing shopping lists, party menus or labels for home-made gifts.

 **Maths:** Keep Skills Sharp Through Everyday Activities

- Use cooking and baking to practise measuring, weighing and timing.
- Play board games or card games that involve counting, estimation and the four operations.
- Look for maths in the world around you—number plates, prices in shops, distances on family road trips.
- Set fun challenges: build the tallest tower, estimate how many steps to the park, or create patterns with blocks or beads

children to process, and families play an important role in helping them navigate this time with confidence.

At home, it can be helpful to:

- Maintain routine where possible. Keeping consistent mealtimes, bedtimes, and after-school expectations provides stability when school life feels busy or unpredictable.
- Talk about change in simple, positive terms. Invite your child to share what they are looking forward to, as well as anything they may be worried about. Normalising these mixed emotions can make a big difference.
- Create space for rest. The end of the year can be physically and emotionally taxing. Quiet afternoons, early nights, or screen-free downtime can support regulation and reduce overwhelm.
- Reflect on the year together. Celebrating growth, strengths, and achievements helps students build a sense of pride and readiness for the next step.
- Preview what's ahead. As information becomes available, gently talk about next year's class structures, new routines, or any changes your child might experience. Predictability supports confidence.

With calm reassurance and simple strategies at home, students are better able to manage the excitement and transition that the end of the year brings. Thank you for your ongoing partnership in supporting student wellbeing.
